

Dr. Brian P. Harris holds the Ph.D. in Music Education from the Florida State University where he studied wind conducting with James Croft, orchestra conducting with Phillip Spurgeon, and arranging/composition with Charles Carter. He received the Master of Music from Louisiana State University, studying conducting with Frank Wickes and arranging with John Edmunds. His Bachelor of Music degree is from Samford University. Prior to joining the University of Texas at San Antonio faculty in 1991, where he was Associate Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music, he taught public school music from 1979 to 1986.

He is author of the internationally-distributed Warner Brothers method book "Directional Warm-Ups for Band" and writes the "Composers of Great Works for Band" series for the Texas Bandmasters Association Journal. He has published and presented clinics and research at state and national levels and remains active as an adjudicator, clinician, and composer. He is President-Elect of the Texas Community Band Directors Association and a member of the Texas Music Educators Association, the Texas Bandmasters Association, Phi Mu Alpha Music Fraternity, and Kappa Kappa Psi Band Fraternity.

Dr. Harris presently serves as Director of Bands at McLennan Community College in Waco, Texas. At MCC, his responsibilities include the MCC Wind Symphony, the Waco Community Band, the Waco Area Youth Wind Ensemble, and the MCC Pep Band.
