Roger Rush, Guest Conductor

Roger Rush was born in southern Oklahoma and began his lifetime band career in grade school as a drummer. During high school, he picked up the baritone horn, played in the Oklahoma All-State Band and served as his school's drum major and student director. He was awarded the James Saied Scholarship Award for Outstanding Instrumetalist at East Central Oklahoma University and was listed in Who's Who in American Universities for 3 years; he then taught band for 7 years in southern Oklahoma public schools His graduate studies were at the University of North Texas, the University of Texas, Michigan State University and the Peabody Conservatory of Music in Baltimore. He was accomplished in low brass and percussion.

Roger has had a wide and varied career as a musical director over some 55 years—he has been a successful band director at the high school and college level, a military band director and as an orchestra director in Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico and Colorado. He founded the Waco Community Band and The Little London Wind ensemble of Colorado Springs prior to his move to Eugene. Oregon in 2001. He has remained active in local ensembles performing and/or conducting the Eugene Symphonic Band, the Oregon Horn Club, The Oregon Tuba Ensemble, and the Central Lutheran Church Chorale and Brass Ensemble.

His crowning achievement has been as the founding Musical Director for the Oregon Brass Society. He has been the driving force behind the Society's many successes and its reputation as a premier brass group in the Northwest—as a conductor, a leader, a mentor and an advocate for the brass band movement. Upon his retirement from the OBS the group bestowed the title "Director Emeritus."
