



### **Section 3 Employment Preference**

Employment opportunities generated by the Housing Authority of the City of Salem will, to the greatest extent feasible, be directed to low-income persons, particularly persons who are the recipients of HUD assistance for housing, under Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968.

**Recipients of HUD housing assistance and other low-income persons are encouraged to apply.**

To qualify for the Section 3 preference, you must either be a public housing resident; or a person who lives in the Salem-Keizer area whose family income does not exceed the following limits.

| <u>Family Size</u> | <u>Income Limit</u> | <u>Family Size</u> | <u>Income limit</u> |
|--------------------|---------------------|--------------------|---------------------|
| 1 Person           | \$38,850            | 5 Person           | \$59,950            |
| 2 Person           | \$44,400            | 6 Person           | \$64,400            |
| 3 Person           | \$49,950            | 7 Person           | \$68,850            |
| 4 Person           | \$55,500            | 8 Person           | \$73,300            |

\* Income limits (80% of median) as published by HUD and made effective 4/24/2019.

If you are a public housing resident, or if your income is less than the amount indicated above for your size of family and you live in the Salem-Keizer area, you qualify!
