

HIGHS AND LOWS FROM LAST WEEK

Two parts of an ancient Native American ceremonial ground will once again be one after a 100-year separation. The Stonington Land Trust acquired a 3.25-acre property on Osbrook Point Road in December that was once part of the adjacent Stanton-Davis Farm. The trust also recently acquired an option to buy a conservation easement on a 168 acre piece of the farm for \$2 million. Both pieces of land were once part of a Native American ceremonial ground. If the five-year-old land trust can raise the money to buy the optioned land it will have ownership or rights to a total of 500 acres in various parts of town, not a bad five-year record of accomplishment.
