STUART AIR SHOW ANNOUNCES CONFIRMATION OF F-16 JET FOR 2015

Martin County, Florida: Military jets made a big comeback to the Stuart Air Show in 2014. Once again, the military will be featured as a headlining act at the 2015 show, scheduled for October 30 – November 1 at Martin County Airport – Witham Field.

“We’ve just received notice that the **US Air Force F-16** is confirmed to perform,” said Don McGlynn, Stuart Air Show Board President. “Since this fighter is flying a limited scheduled, we’re honored to have been selected.”

The F-16, known as the “Fighting Falcon,” is also commonly referred to as the “Viper” by its pilots. Key features include a frameless bubble canopy for maximum visibility, a side-mounted control stick for easy maneuvering, and a seat reclined to 30 degrees to reduce the effect of g-forces on the pilot. The F-16 is also the first to use a fly-by-wire flight control system which allows the aircraft to be nimble.

Plans to include a US Air Force “Heritage Flight” with a P-51 Mustang is also in the works. The program honors the “greatest generation” who built, maintained, and flew front line fighters during WWII.

In addition to the USAF F-16, the **US Army Golden Knights** are confirmed to perform. The Golden Knights are widely renowned as the world’s best parachute team. The Team has dominated national and international competitions and has already earned the US Army an impressive 2,148 Gold; 1,117 Silver, and 693 Bronze Medals and as broken 348 world records.

The F-16 will perform on Saturday, October 31 and Sunday, November 1. The US Army Golden Knights will perform both Saturday and Sunday as well as at the exciting Friday Night air show on Friday, October 30.
