US NAVY F-18 JOINS MILITARY ACTS FEATURED AT 2015 STUART AIR SHOW

Martin County, Florida: The **US Navy F-18** fighter jet joins the list of top military acts for the 2015 Stuart Air Show, to be held October 30 – November 1 at Martin County Airport – Witham Field.

Already confirmed to perform are the **US Army Golden Knights** and the **US Air Force F-16**. The addition of the **US NAVY F-18** as a third military act to headline at the Stuart Air Show brings the military presence at this annual event to an awe-inspiring level.

Known as the “Hornet,” the F-18 has a top speed of Mach 1.8, the equivalent of 1,190 mph and is equipped to carry a variety of bombs and missiles. Two F404 turbo fan engines ensure the aircraft’s high thrust-to-weight ratio while its characteristic aerodynamic frame allows the aircraft to maneuver easily at top speeds.

“Having three military acts is amazing,” said Don McGlynn, President of the Stuart Air Show. “We’re also working on plans for a US Navy “Legacy Flight” with BOTH an SB2C “Helldiver” and an F-4U “Corsair” that will fly with the F-18 in recognition of fighter pilots who served our country in WWII.”

The F-18 will perform on Saturday, October 31 and Sunday, November 1 along with the F-16. The US Army Golden Knights will perform both Saturday and Sunday as well as at the Friday Night air show on Friday, October 30.
