

Nenescape volunteer role profile – EYES team

Role title: Nenescape Engagement, Youth and Events Support (EYES) team

Location: You'll have a choice of locations, based on where you live and how you'd like to be involved. Locations are likely to include Nene Park Trust (Ferry Meadows), Stanwick Lakes, country parks, town centres and plenty more.

When and how often: This role is based around engagement events that we and our partner organisations will run, so it's likely to include office hours and potentially some weekends. The length of the projects depends on their size and the location, so we can discuss the opportunities when we meet you.

Travel required: We will invite you to our office for an informal chat when you have completed an application form. Once you are ready to start volunteering, we will discuss the best locations for you to be based.

Travel expenses: We offer you the opportunity to claim back 45p per mile or public transport costs (up to a reasonable limit). We will ensure you have access to an expense claim form and show you what details we need to be shown on it.

Duration of volunteering role: In order for the project to work effectively, we recommend that you are able to offer a couple of months, but we can be flexible and welcome the opportunity to discuss your needs.

Potential areas of work:

- Consultation events
- Schools programmes/outreach
- Stewarding at partner events or sites
- Monitoring and evaluating interpretation (e.g displays, trails, digital apps, etc)
- Poster/leaflet/questionnaire distribution
- Activity leading (e.g crafts, education, tours)
- Record-keeping of individuals engaging with Nenescape
- Going to occasional board meetings, conferences/seminars/etc if interested
- Contributing to website articles and newsletter
- Attending training as necessary

Why we want you:

You have an interest in the heritage of the area around you and love sharing stories with other people from all walks of life. You would like to learn new skills and are happy to work in team or on your own. You're enthusiastic and a friendly face. You want to gain something for yourself from volunteering with us, whether it's meeting new people or brushing up your CV. You might come from a minority ethnic background or have a disability. Join a team who will help other people explore their local area through events, marketing and engagement activities.

What we can offer you:

- Training and ongoing guidance for your role, both from our partner organisations and the Nenescape team
- Social activities in the summer and at Christmas and a social trip
- A branded fleece and name badge
