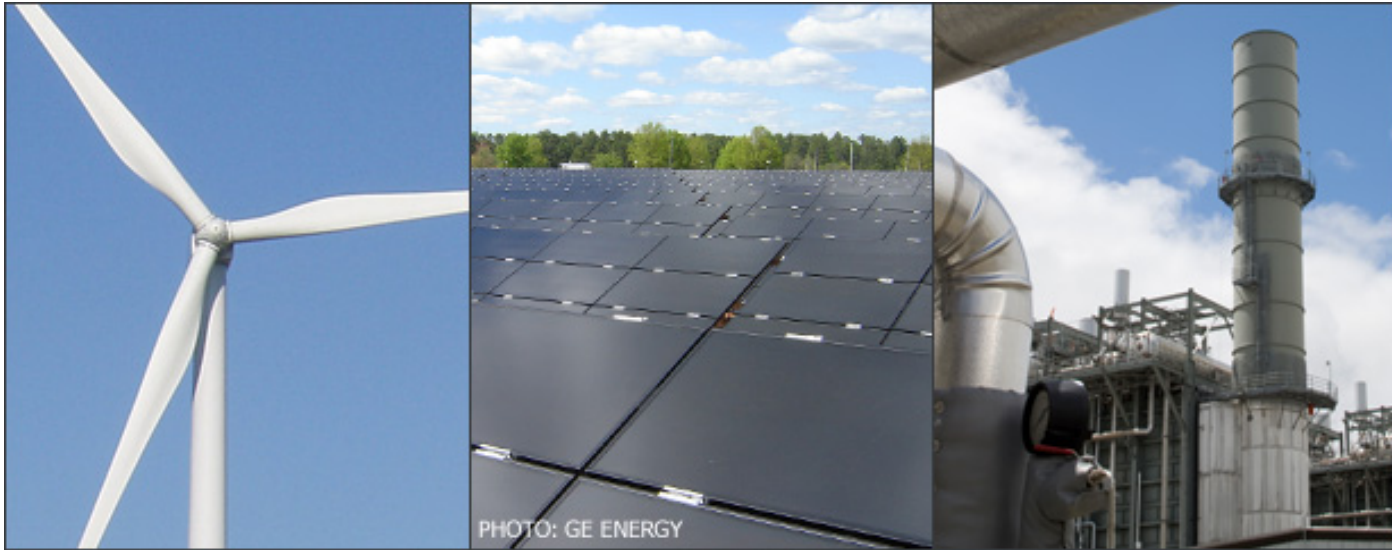

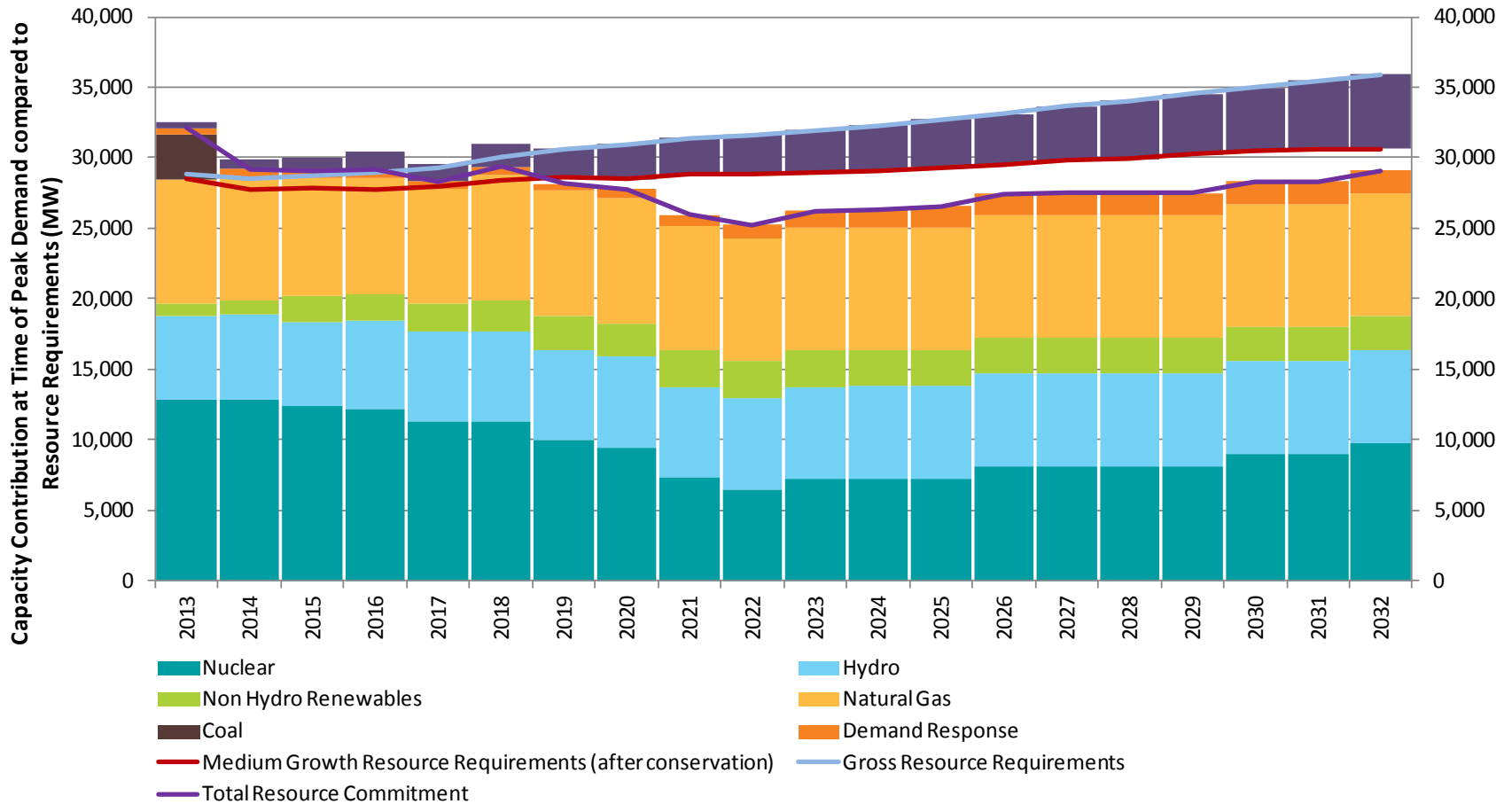

Introduction to Invenergy

- ┆ Invenergy LLC is headquartered in Chicago
- ┆ Offices in Toronto, Denver, Warsaw, Mexico City and Tokyo
- ┆ North America's largest independent renewable energy generation company (6th largest overall)
- ┆ Developed 9,000 MW+ in North America & Europe
- ┆ 980 MW in Canada. Ontario projects include:
 - ┆ St. Clair Energy Centre 580 MW natural gas plant in Corunna
 - ┆ Raleigh Wind Energy Centre 78 MW in Chatham-Kent
 - ┆ Woodville & Sandringham Solar Energy Centres 20 MW solar in Kawartha Lakes

Energy Supply Needs in Ontario



The graphic above reflects the Government's LTEP scenario indicating the need for new generation supply starting in 2019

Large Renewable Procurement - Request for Proposals (LRP I RFP)

- † Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO)
- † Competitive bidding process
 - † No similarity to the previous Feed In Tariff program administered by the Ontario Power Authority (OPA)
- † IESO has qualified 42 companies for a maximum of 300 MW of wind power in specific regions of Ontario
- † Invenergy has qualified to participate and will submit the Strong Breeze Wind Project
- † RFP bid submission date is September 1, 2015



IESO LRP Mandatory Requirements

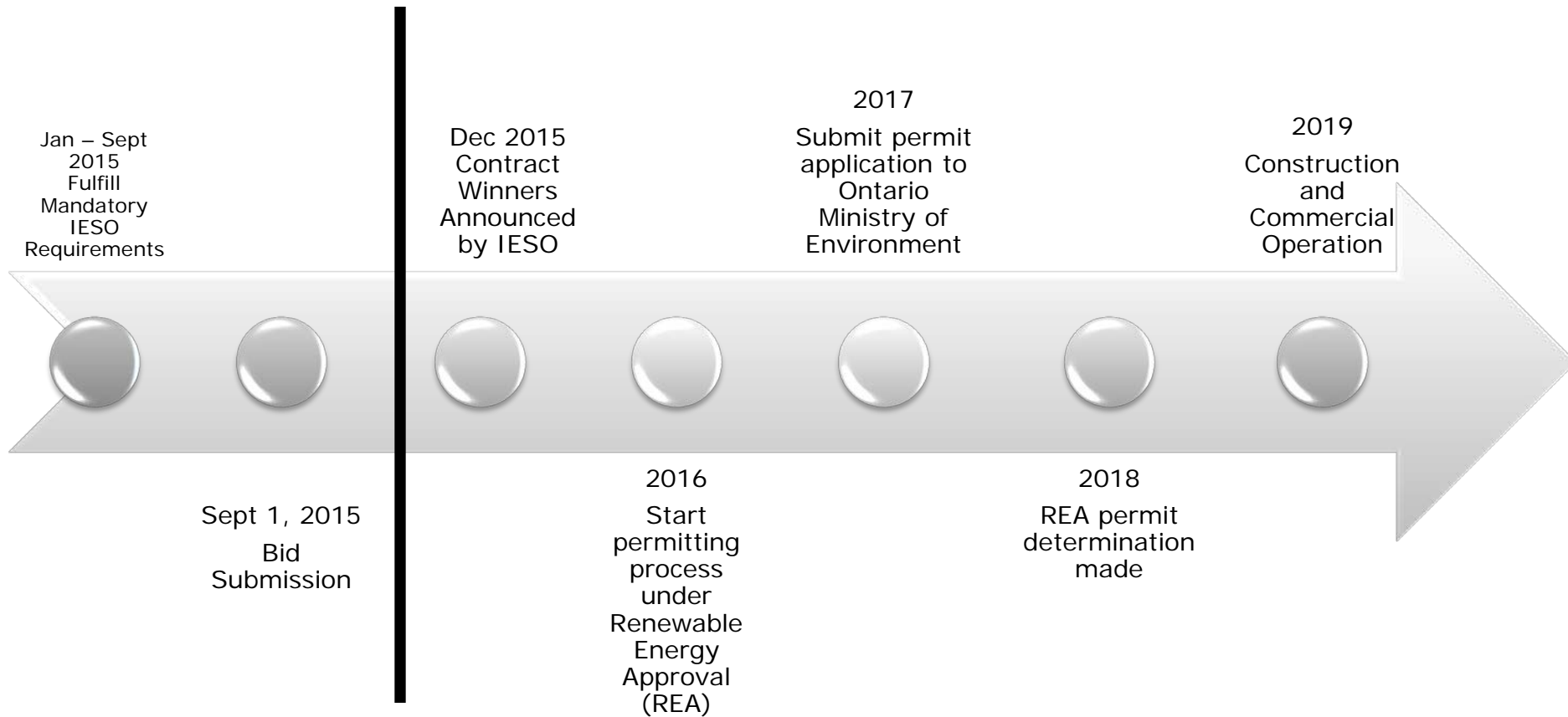
- There are a number of mandatory requirements that Strong Breeze needs to complete prior to submitting a bid:
 - Delegation to council (completed)
 - Public meeting (today)
 - Web page (www.invenenergyllc.com/strongbreeze)
 - Community engagement plan (posted on website)
 - Notices, site considerations, prescribed forms, financial security, independent resource confirmations etc.

Strong Breeze Wind Project

- † 60 MW wind farm located in Dutton Dunwich
- † 20 to 25 wind turbines expected between 2 MW to 3 MW in size
- † Proposing to connect 230 kV transmission circuit north of 401
- † Layout configuration and turbine details are under consideration
- † The local Erie Breezes Energy Co-op (EBEC) has been launched and is accepting membership
- † Community Working Group meeting regularly at the Dutton Dunwich council chambers

Timeline for the Strong Breeze Wind Project

Community Benefit Dutton Dunwich

- † EBEC will be offered minority stake in the project
- † Council has requested to negotiate an agreement relating to Strong Breeze on a without prejudice basis
- † The IESO RFP creates an unparalleled opportunity for the Municipality of Dutton Dunwich
 - † Setbacks from towns and hamlets
 - † Per megawatt annual financial contribution
 - † Decommissioning security
