

# NOTICE OF A DRAFT SITE PLAN

## by Strong Breeze Wind Power Partnership to Engage in a Renewable Energy Project

**Project Name:** Strong Breeze Wind Project (the Project)

**IESO Reference #:** L-006347-WIN-001-057

**Project Location:** The Project will be located in the Municipality of Dutton Dunwich and County of Elgin, Ontario, and is generally bounded by Chalmers Line to the north, Coyne Road to the west, Iona Road to the east, and Erin Line to the south.

**Dated at the Municipality of Dutton Dunwich, the 16th day of March, 2017**

Strong Breeze Wind Power Partnership is planning to engage in a renewable energy project in respect of which the issuance of a Renewable Energy Approval (REA) is required. The distribution of this Notice of a Draft Site Plan and the Project itself are subject to the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act* (the Act) Part V.0.1 and Ontario Regulation 359/09 (the Regulation). This Notice must be distributed in accordance with section 54.1 of the Regulation prior to an application being submitted to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change.

### Project Description:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the wind facility, in respect of which the Project is to be engaged in, is considered to be a Class 4 Wind Facility. If approved, this wind facility would have a total maximum name plate capacity of up to 57.5 MW and up to 20 turbines. This Project is being proposed in accordance with the requirements of the Act and Regulation. The Project Location is described in the map below.

### Draft Site Plan:

A Draft Site Plan identifying, among other things, the location of wind turbines and transformer substation has been made available to the public for review at the locations noted below. The legal effect of this Notice is such that pursuant to the Regulation, the Project must consider noise receptors as defined by the Act that existed only as of March 15, 2017.

### Noise Assessment Report:

A draft Noise Assessment Report that demonstrates how the placement of turbines and the substation transformer comply with the Ministry of the Environment's 2008 publication entitled "Noise Guidelines for Wind Farms" has been issued for the Project and is available to the public for review at the locations noted below.
