Founded in 2013 by Tony and Christine Lombardi, Lombardi Wines honors a rich family history of wine, food and tradition. Together, with Winemaker Cabell Coursey, they craft small lots of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from some of the finest vineyards along the Sonoma Coast. The Pinot Noir is made with care from a family of growers in Petaluma, where the Lombardi family has been since 1947.

AROMATICS

This Petaluma Gap Pinot Noir reveals dark aromas of blackberry, black cherry and ripe currants in the nose with a dust of cocoa.

ON THE PALATE

The 2016 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir delivers dark black fruits that slowly melt into all areas of the mouth. There is focused acidity and fine dry tannins that carry the rich blackberry, anise, cedar, black licorice and mocha flavors toward the mid-palate, leading to a lingering juicy finish of black cherry and dried currants.
