Amber Road's interior architecture for Japanese-inspired Ume Burger is anything but cliché. The design of the 4.2-metre tall shopfront artfully plays with proportion, perfection and imperfection: a series of glass, volcanic rock and steel rectangles, long and tall, provide a unique patchwork, with pitted volcanic rock cladding the split façade and framing the service counter. Playful accents include a blue vending machine, a custom mobilecart with exaggerated circular forms as wheels, and external seating paired with Hay's Pallisade features. This small 49-square-metre tenancy located at Barangaroo is definitely a must-see, must-eat.

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
