A growing area of our ministry includes knitting and crocheting gifts to send to patients and staff at our 30 supported care centers. Lovingly made handcrafted items make a lasting impression and warm many hearts, bodies, and minds – especially during the long winter months when temperatures drop and fuel for heating is scarce.



T tems we have sent include:

knitted or crocheted hats, scarves, and gloves

knitted, quilted, or fleece blankets

weaters, shawls, and wraps

handmade dolls

knitted squares

We ask that contributors send a photograph of themselves or their group when sending items to us.
