Our annual All Members' Show showcases the diversity of our collective. This non-juried exhibit is designed to include everyone, from beginners to veterans! If you've never entered your calligraphy into an exhibit, this is for you!

Weathergrams were created by master calligrapher Lloyd Reynolds to give his students a creative outlet to practice their writing skills. Based loosely on Japanese haikus, a weathergram is a poem or short message of about ten words or less written on brown kraft paper. They are hung from bushes or trees to weather in the elements like old leaves. The subject matter is typically seasonal in nature; however, other verses are welcome.

Who is eligible?

Any current member of the CCC: every age, every level!

What is eligible?

Each entry will consist of a strip of paper approximately 2 1/2 inches wide x 10 inches in length with one end folded over 1 1/2 - 2 inches. Brown kraft paper is typically used, but any paper will be accepted. The ink used must be waterproof when dry.

Is there an entry fee?

No, there is no entry fee.

Is there a per person limit?

Yes, each member may submit up to 5 weathergrams. NOTE: They will NOT be returned.

When is the deadline for entries?

All entries, along with a completed and signed entry form are due by November 27.

How do I get my work back?

Your work will NOT be returned. Once the exhibit closes, we will hang the weathergrams around the library and the grounds of the Irish American Heritage Center.
