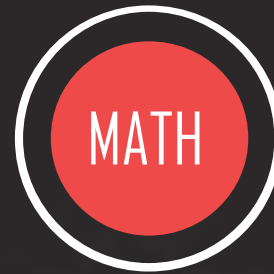
INTRODUCTION

The Common Core Math exam is usually taken in May. The Math exam will take place from May 1 to May 3 in 2019.

LEVELS



The Common Core exams are scored on a scale from 1 to 4. All students should strive to achieve a score of 3 or 4 on the exam. A student's score on the exam reflects their understanding of the Common Core Standards; something that many selective schools look out for during the admissions process. This is why it is very important for students to prepare as much as possible for these exams.

OUR PROGRAM

Synergy Prep strives to push all students to their ultimate limit and help them achieve the best grades possible in school and on the state exams. Here's what our program consists of:

The Basics



Time

Our Common Core program is held on two days of the week. One day of the week our students are taught ELA for a 2-hour session. The other day they are taught Math for a 2-hour session.



Lesson Plans

Each 2-hour session consists of a carefully, well-thought out lesson plan created by our instructors. These lesson plans will go over the topic of the day which usually revolves around a specific Common Core standard.



Classwork & Homework

Classwork consisting of main points from the lesson plan are given to the students to assess their knowledge of whatever was taught to them by the instructor. Afterwards, instructors review the classwork with students. Answering any and all questions. Instructors grade the work and returns it to the student. Homework is given at the end of a session and is reviewed the following week.



Ratios

To ensure the utmost quality, we make sure that students are taught in ratios of 4-6 students to one instructor. Doing this will provide students with a more personalized teaching experience and give them the attention they need.

V I R T U A L L E A R N I N G

- A breakdown of which standards/topics were covered on a class by class basis

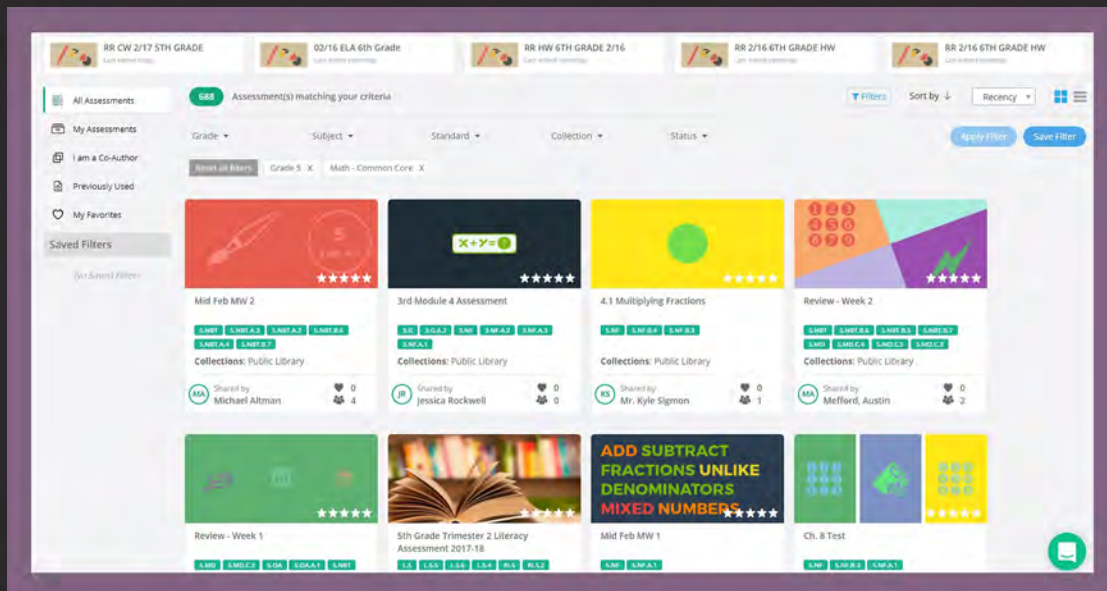

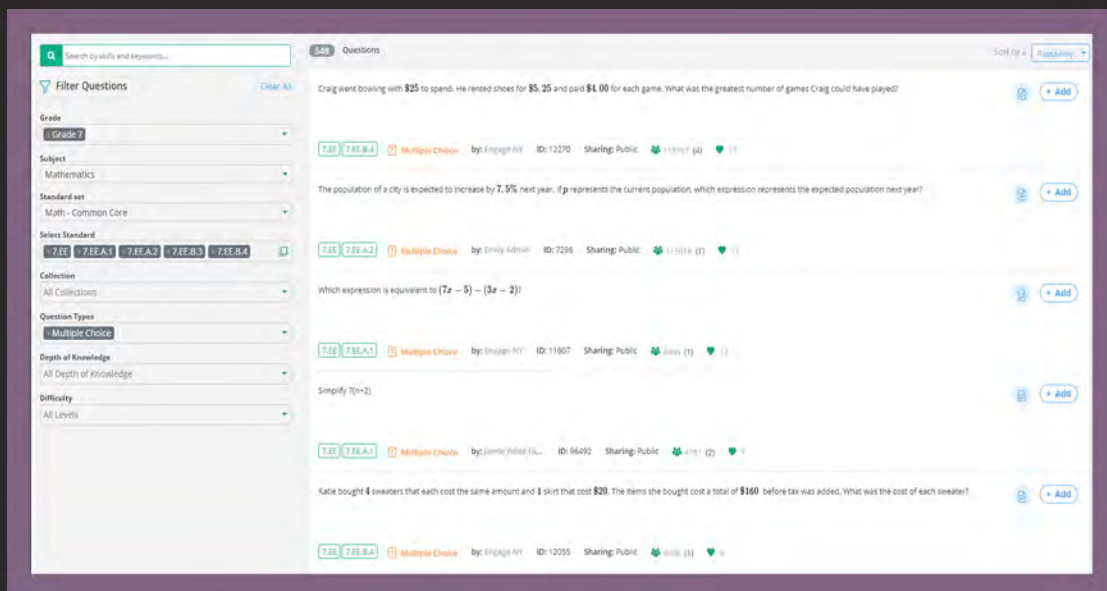

Using our Virtual Learning, instructors can choose from any Common Core standard to assign work to students. They can also choose from an enormous library of questions for each standard.



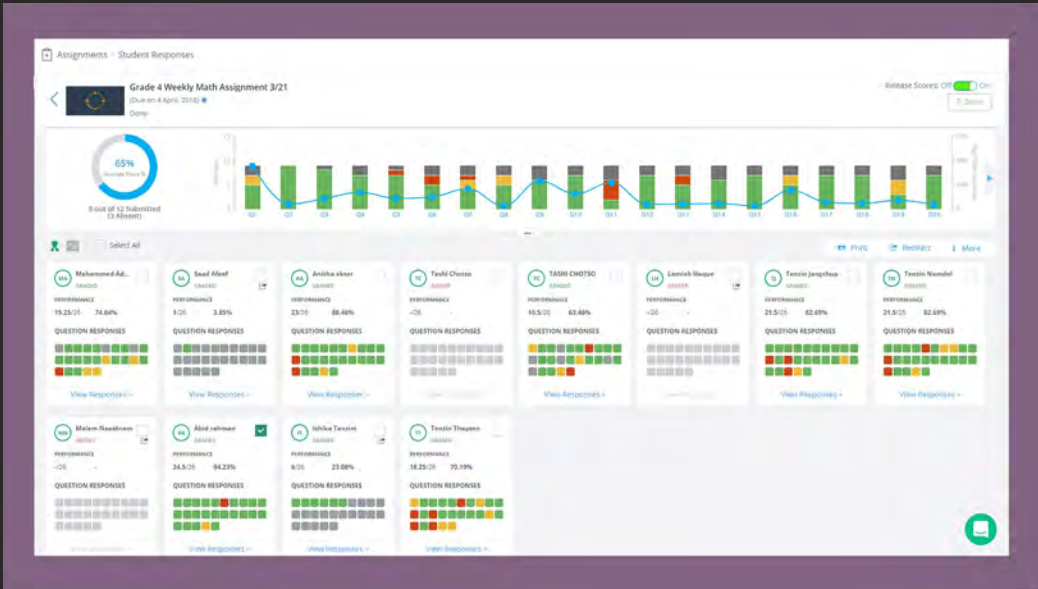

How can I help the student with his/her areas of difficulty?

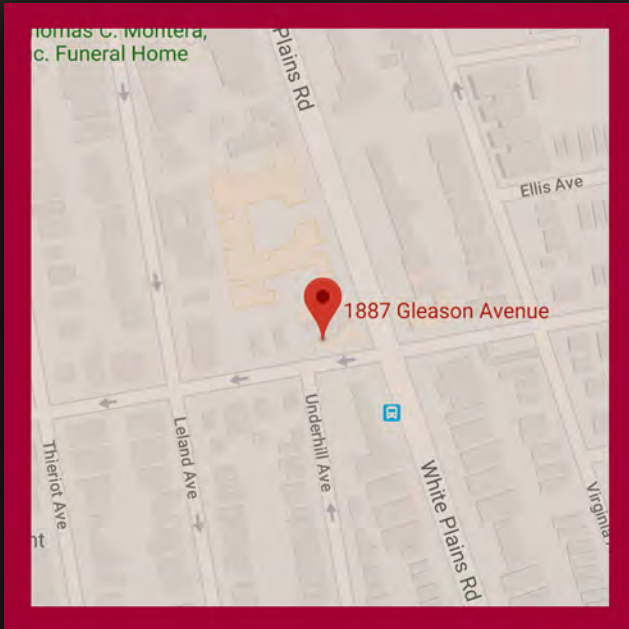
What actions can the student take to help himself/herself?
