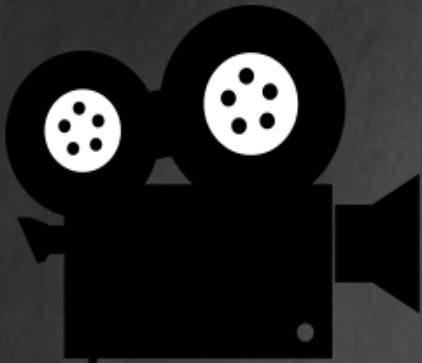

Drivers Not Stopping

In 2016 there were 1608 reported incidents of drivers passing stopped school buses. The majority of those incidents happened when people were driving toward the school bus in the opposite lane. A driver is required to stop regardless of whether they are following the bus or driving toward it when the red lights are flashing.

No appointment, meeting, or event is worth putting a young life at risk, so stay legal, stay safe, and when the red lights are flashing, don't be passing!
