**COURSE:**

## Domestic Highway Enforcement Training Conference

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Domestic Highway Enforcement Conference is a coordinated strategy that will help promote collaborative, intelligence-led, unbiased policing. This conference will reflect multi-jurisdictional law enforcement efforts on the Nation's highways and international borders. During this five-day conference, our trainers will focus on enhancing investigations to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking and money laundering organizations. Professional smugglers utilize our nation's roadways to transport contraband and prey on innocent civilians. These professional smugglers travel to small towns and often travel in rural areas to avoid contact with law enforcement. Our team of seasoned instructors will cover the latest tactics used by law enforcement agencies all around the world.

We will demonstrate how to collect and share valuable information throughout the law enforcement community. Networking, operational planning and coordinating among federal, state and local law enforcement is crucial to our mission. Enhancing our ability in the law enforcement community to communicate will greatly reduce threats to our nation's roadways and our local communities.

This training conference will cover all forms of transportation used by professional smuggling organizations. We will cover Hotel and Motel Interdiction techniques. Smugglers utilize storage units to hide their illegal contraband, which are common in most cities in the U.S. We will also cover how to develop intelligence leading to the arrest and apprehension of these professional smugglers. Students will be shown the latest concealment methods used by criminals to transport contraband in commercial and passenger vehicles. Our staff will utilize ten vehicles that will contain more than 150 different concealment methods for hands-on searching of vehicles for students.

During this five-day conference, students will have the opportunity to choose from a list of breakout courses. These courses are for criminal investigators, highway interdiction officers, road officers and support staff. Each course will be submitted to Idaho Post for continuing education credit hours.
