**JAMES PATRICK CALHOUN** (b. 1688 County Tyrone, Ireland—d. 1741 Chestnut Level, PA), *the son of Alexander Calhoun and Judith Hamilton*, married to **CATHERINE MONTGOMERY** (b. abt. 1684 Donegal, Ireland—d. Feb 1, 1760 Granville Co., SC), *the daughter of Captain Hugh Montgomery and Jane Hamilton*. Children:

**MARY CATHERINE CALHOUN** (b. 1714 Donegal, Ireland—d. 1756 Granville Co., SC), *the daughter of James Patrick Calhoun and Catherine Montgomery*, married **JOHN NOBLE**, b. 1713—d. abt. 1751 Augusta Co., VA.

**JAMES CALHOUN** (b. 1716 Donegal, Ireland—d. Feb. 1, 1760 Granville Co., SC), *son of James Patrick Calhoun and Catherine Montgomery*, married **SUSANNAH NANCY LONG** (b. 1720 Ireland—d. Feb. 1, 1760 Granville Co., SC), *daughter of Joseph Young and Ann Crockett*.

Martha Calhoun, *the daughter of James Calhoun and Nancy Long*, married James Willson. He was killed at Cowpens on January 17, 1781. Their daughter, **Elizabeth** (b. Mar 15, 1776 SC—d. July 10, 1840 Pickens Dist., SC) married **John McWhorter** (b. Oct 30, 1768 in PA—d. Feb 19, 1855 Walker Co., GA), *son of David McWhorter and Mary Poston*.

**EZEKIEL CALHOUN** (b. 1720 Donegal, Ireland—d. May 25, 1762 Max Meadows, VA, while visiting the old home place), *son of James Patrick Calhoun and Catherine Montgomery*, married **JEAN [JANE] EWING** (b. 1725 Ireland—d. 1766 Granville Co., SC). Children:

- (5) Catherine, b. 1752 Augusta Co., VA—d. Feb 3, 1803 SC; m. Jan. 7, 1768, to Major Alexander Noble, b. 1733 Chestnut Level, PA—d. Feb 15, 1802 Abbeville Dist., SC, *son of John Noble and Mary Catherine Calhoun*;

- (6) Patrick, b. 1754 Augusta Co., VA—d. 1828 SC; m. Eleanor Baskin, b. Dec 1746—d. Nov 1, 1803 Pendleton Dist., SC, *daughter of James Baskin and Margaret Pickens*; and
- (7) Ezekiel Jr., b. Feb 12, 1756 Augusta Co., VA—d. ca. Jan 25, 1817 SC.

**WILLIAM CALHOUN** (b. 1723 Donegal, Ireland—d. 1789 Abbeville Dist., SC), *son of James Patrick Calhoun and Catherine Montgomery*, married October 19, 1749 VA, to **AGNES NANCY LONG**, (b. 1730—d. 1794 Abbeville Dist., SC), *daughter of Joseph Young and Ann Crockett*. Children:

- (1) Col. Joseph, b. Oct 22, 1750 Augusta Co., VA—d. Apr 14, 1817 Abbeville Dist., SC; m. (i) to Catherine Calhoun, b. 1749—d. 1791; and (ii) May 26, 1802, to Martha Moseley, b. 1780—d. 1835, *daughter of William Moseley*;
- (2) Catherine, b. Feb 4, 1753 Augusta Co., VA—d. Feb 1, 1760 Granville Co., SC;
- (3) Anne, b. May 18, 1755 Augusta Co., VA—d. Dec 19, 1830; was held in captivity fourteen years; m. Oct 12, 1784, to Isaac Matthews, d. Mar 25, 1801 SC;
- (4) Mary, b. Nov 1, 1757 Granville Co., SC—d. captured by the Indians on Feb 1, 1760 Granville Co., SC, and never heard from again;
- (5) Patrick, b. Feb 18, 1760 SC—d. Jun 26, 1776 SC; killed by the Indians while serving in Capt. James McCall's expedition into the Cherokee lands; m. Alice Craig;
- (6) Rachel, b. Sept 19, 1762 Granville Co., SC—d. \_\_\_ ; m. Patrick Norris, b. 1762—d. 1840;
- (7) Esther, b. Sept 30, 1765 Granville Co., SC—d. March 2, 1844 KY; m. (i) William Carter Love, b. 1765—d. Aug 27, 1799 KY, *son of Joseph Love and Mary Teas [or Tays]*; (ii) J. Kuykendall, d. 1811; and (iii) Feb 5, 1812 KY, to William Alton;
- (8) William, b. Apr 5, 1768 Ninety-Six Dist., SC—d. 1827; m. Rebecca Tannehill, b. abt. 1770, *daughter of James Tannehill and Catherine Hill*;
- (9) Ezekiel, b. Nov 27, 1770 Ninety-Six Dist., SC—d. Jan 25, 1817 Abbeville, SC; m. Feb 26, 1796, to Frances Hamilton, b. Feb 13, 1773 Abbeville, SC—d. Feb 12, 1848 SC, *daughter of Major Andrew Hamilton and Jane McGill*;
- (10) Agnes, b. Aug 29, 1773 Ninety-Six Dist., SC—d. Sept 5, 1840 Green Co., AL; m. Gen. Joseph Hutton, b. Dec 28, 1769 Ninety-Six Dist., SC—d. Aug 30, 1823 Green Co., AL; and
- (11) Alexander, b. Dec 21, 1776 Ninety-Six Dist., SC—d. \_\_\_ ; m. Kitty Johnson.

**PATRICK CALHOUN** (b. Jun 11, 1727 Donegal, Ireland—d. Jan 15, 1796 Abbeville Dist., SC), *son of James Patrick Calhoun and Catherine Montgomery*, married (i) **ALICE CRAIGHEAD** (b. 1742—d. Sept 10, 1766 SC, at the age of twenty-four after the miscarriage of twins), *the daughter of Rev. Alexander Craighead*, and (ii) Jun 2, 1770, to **MARTHA CALDWELL** (b. 1750 VA—d. May 1802 SC), *daughter of Captain William Caldwell and Rebecca Parks*. Children of Patrick and Martha:
