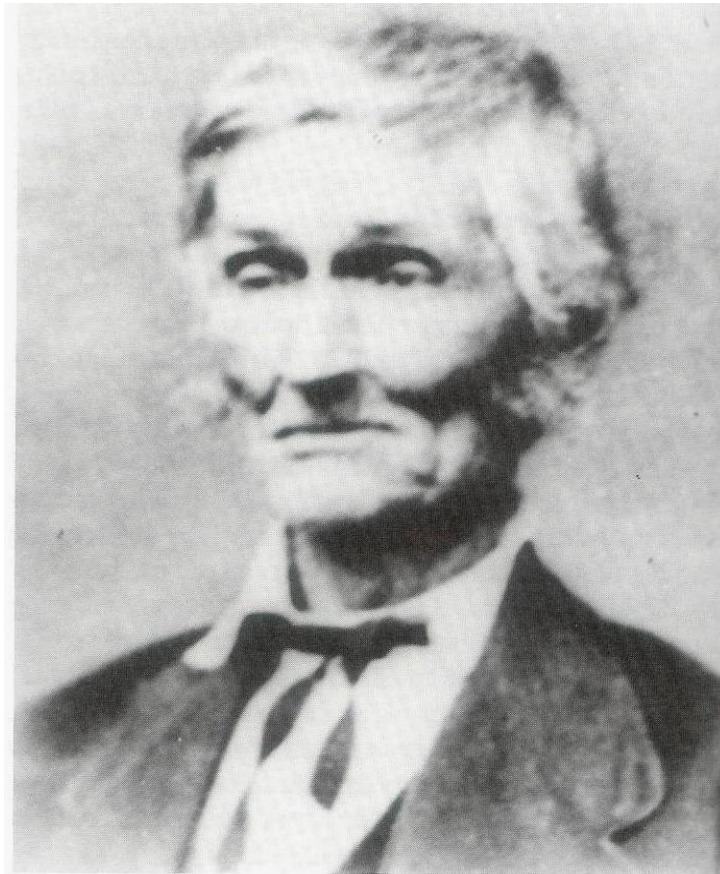


Rev. David Humphreys **1855-1858**

Rev. Humphreys was born in North Carolina, moved to Pendleton as a young man, and finally settled in the Pickens District. He was licensed to preach in October 1819. In the summer of 1821, Rev. David Humphreys came to Anderson, SC and was installed as pastor of Roberts (1789) and Good Hope (1789) Presbyterian Churches. He pastored Roberts for most of his life, serving from 1821-1835, and then continued to serve as supply pastor for another seven years.

Rev. Humphreys' service to Bethel, according to the Minutes of Session where recorded, appeared to be the leading of a series of protracted meetings at various times during 1855-1858.

Rev. Humphreys died September 28, 1869. Both he and his wife are buried at Roberts Presbyterian Church, Anderson County.
