

Rev. Henry Dixon Corbett

1945 — 1947



Rev. H. D. Corbett, as a senior student at the Theological Seminary in Columbia, was called to preach twice a month at the Upper Long Cane Presbyterian Church in Abbeville, SC until his graduation, at which time a call would take effect. Mr. Corbett accepted on April 2, 1916 at a salary of \$1,200.00 a year. Rev. Corbett resigned in 1919.

May 13, 1945

A congregational meeting was held at the church Sunday, May 13, 1945. Rev. R.B. Dupree presided at the meeting. **The congregation voted unanimously to call Rev. H.B. Corbett as pastor.** He was informed at once of this action.
