Ron Kittelson: School to Work Alliance Program Coordinator serving Norwood and West End

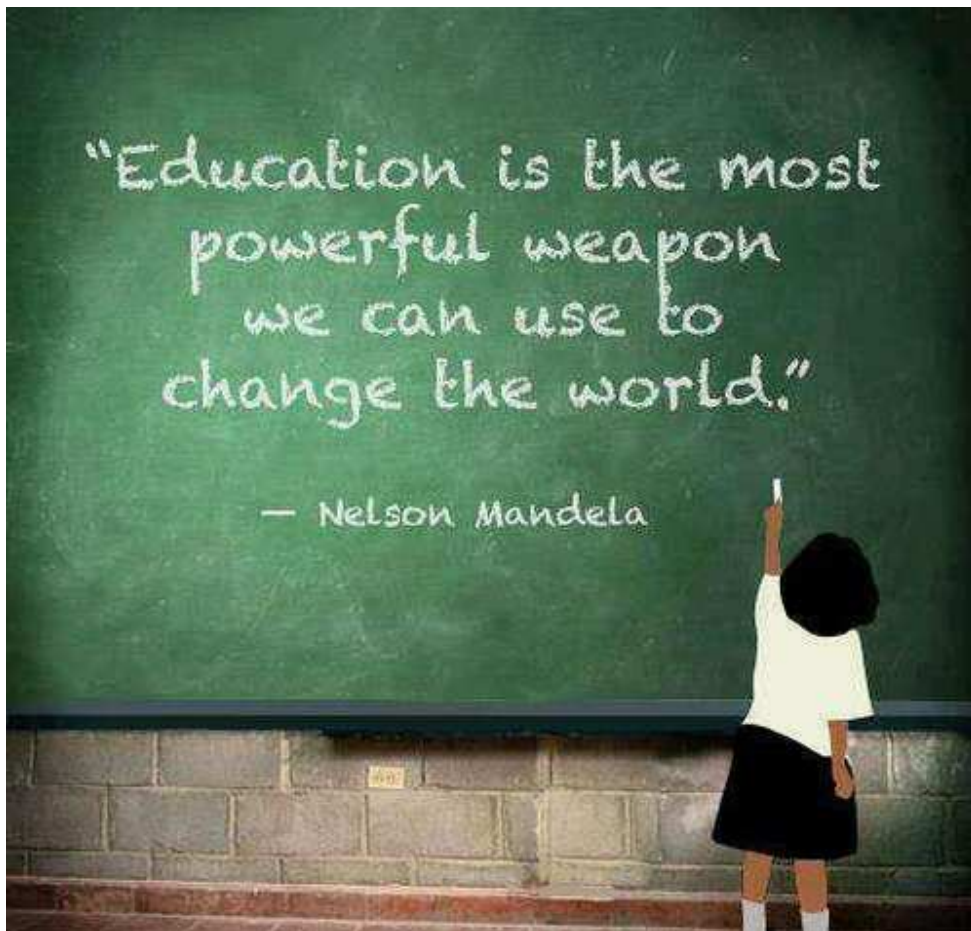
Brittany Rogers: BCBA Behavior Coach serving all 5 districts
