## Teachers Needed

Valerie and Mike Moon return to the U.S. this week, leaving a big vacancy in the teacher ranks at White Dove. The Moons have been teaching third, fourth, and fifth grades since the beginning of this school year. Their departure means that Suyapa and Arturo will both have to pick up an added load of teaching in addition to the administration and oversight of the growing school until more teachers come.

## A Proposal

In anticipation of their departure, Arturo sent out this note recently:

*Dear brothers and friends:*

*May the GRACE of our LORD JESUS CHRIST be with you all.*

*As you know we are in the constant search of teachers for White Dove. An exceptional opportunity has come to our attention. Pastor Melvin has been talking with a missionary who has been in Honduras in the past and is familiar with the White Dove School, since he has taught in San Pedro.*

*Now he and his wife are retired and they are willing to come to Honduras (Santa Clara) and be with us for 3 years.*

*This is the issue: the ticket from Philippines to Honduras costs \$ 3,200. Pastor Melvin will put half of the ticket on his credit card mileage. The rest of the amount or approximately \$1600 is need to cover the rest of the trip from Honolulu to Miami and SPS. This amount also includes the cost of the visas (US and HN).*

*Please let us know if any financial help can be possible, so we can give the green light and proceed since next week Valerie and Mike will be gone.*

## More Information

The plan is that the husband (Rex) will come to Santa Clara as soon as travel can be arranged, and his wife (Lina) will come after December 15 when she finishes a work commitment in the Philippines. Both would teach.

The first need is visas. Rex and Lina must each have a U.S. transit visa plus a Honduras visa. In order for them to stay three years in Honduras they will need a "missionary visa" which requires endorsement

by their home church and denomination spokesmen. Four such letters of recommendation were issued today (April 7) to fulfill that requirement.

The next hurdle is the cost of getting the U.S. and Honduras visas--\$750. Once the visas are in hand, the most economical flights can be arranged.

So the immediate need is \$750 to enable Rex to get his visas so the travel can be arranged. **WHO WILL BE THE ANGEL TO MEET THIS NEED?**

*In the interest of full disclosure: The remaining cost for Rex's travel will be determined after the flights are arranged. A second request of similar amount could be expected in December to cover the costs for bringing his wife.*
