Dinosaur Hunt and Caving Expedition

Kids everywhere are fascinated by dinosaurs and what you might find in a big, dark cave. But how many are actually able to experience what it might be like to be a caver? Or how they might search for dinosaur bones? White Dove students got a taste of both things recently.

Students in 4th to 7th grade traveled to the museum in San Pedro Sula last month for this special learning opportunity. After being outfitted with their caving-safety hats and caver vests,



they heard about the wonders of cave exploration and the safety aspects to remember. Then they entered the cave for the new experiences.



Do you remember your caving experience? Eerie quiet except for dripping water? Absolutely black darkness? Critters hanging from the ceiling? Disorientation?



They got the whole package. But where are the dinosaurs? They weren't in the cave!!!

You have to know where and how to find them. You trade your safety hat and caver's vest for a sun hat; you look in the right place, with the right tools to find dinosaurs. You don't find them walking around, but you might find evidence they were there a long time ago. You have to be careful if you find something that might be what you're looking for.



And if you are lucky, you hit pay dirt and uncover that fossil that tells the story!



Now you have some new experiences that most kids miss. Because you were at White Dove School.
