

# 229 POLICEMEN QUALIFY FOR CAPTAINCIES

## Top 20 Lieutenants to Be Promoted

A new eligibility list for positions as city police captains was posted yesterday by the Chicago Civil Service Commission. Police Supt. Orlando W. Wilson said he would promote at least 20 from the list "as soon as we can process them."

The list included names of 229 police lieutenants out of 233 who took the examination last Feb. 3. The top grade was made by James J. Riordan, director of the organized crime division, with Michael Spiotto, director of the burglary detail, a close second.

Await Military Credits The promotions will be delayed briefly to permit claiming of military preference credits. Those on the list can have up to 3.5 points added to their grades, provided their military credits were not used in previous promotional tests. Wilson ordered lieutenants to submit such claims within 24 hours.

The top 20 on the list, apparently headed for quick promotions unless moved downward by military preference claims, range in age from 27 to 54.

The "baby" is No. 20, Thomas J. Lyons, 27, who, if named, apparently would be the youngest police captain in the history of the department. Another "youngster" is James C. Holzman, 32, who ranked eighth.

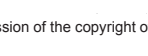
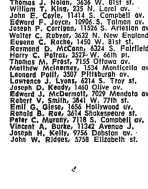
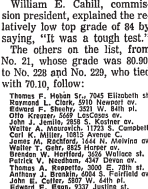
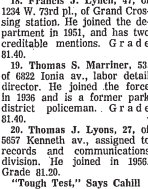
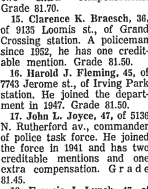
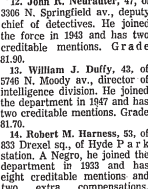
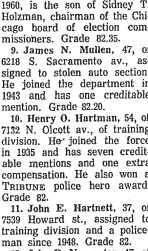
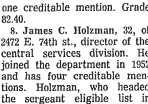
Negro Ties for 13th Robert M. Harness, tied for 13th, apparently will become the second Negro police captain. The present Negro captain is 61.50.
