Inspired by these quirky terms, Midnight Sun is presenting some favorites in the form of beer. So whether you live in Alaska or Outside, let your taste buds interpret our language via your glass.

Suicide Run:

Of Alaska's five indigenous salmon species--chinook (king), chum (dog), coho (silver), pink (humpy) and sockeye (red), it's the reds that draw us down to the Russian River to harvest this plentiful anadromous fish during its spawning runs. The term "suicide run" refers to the 110-mile road trip between Anchorage and the Russian River. Usually after a regular work day but fueled by long daylight hours, folks drive down while the runs are hot, fish 'til they limit out, drive back home then go to work. This is one way to fill our freezers.
