International Application Fee / Additional Fees and/or Incidentals

The application fee for an international study applicant is \$200.00. This begins the application process. Once you go through our application process and you are accepted you are required to do a \$1500.00 new student deposit. It is due within 10-15 days of the acceptance letter. Deposit and Application Fee can be wire transferred. Please request the wire instructions from the admissions office. We also require an Enrollment Agreement with a choice of a 1 or 2 payment plans. Payments are on June 20 and Nov. 20 for the coming school year enrollment. This payment plan is based on a full year enrollment – August thru June. An invoice will be done to clearly state all the fees that are involved prior to doing the I-20 and consulate letter.

Our school year is from August 21 through June 1.

Parents/Students are also responsible for additional fees; such as:

- School Trip Fees: \$600.00 - \$1600 per year
Please refer to the Tuition & Fee Schedule on our website for the most up to date fees. Cost depends on grade attending.
- 1-20 Student Visa Fee: \$200.00 for term of enrollment. You will still need to register at the US embassy and pay and additional I-901 fee (approx. cost \$200.00).
- School Supplies: Cost can range between \$200-\$250.00 per year. A School supply list provided upon acceptance.
- Picture Day Photo Package: Cost can range from \$25.00 - \$65.00 per year depending on photo package. School pictures are taken in September and October.
- Instrument Rental: if participating in Orchestra/Band. Cost can range between \$50.00-\$100.00 a month.
- School Year Book: \$45.00 per year. Year books ordered in December. If purchased after the deadline you will incur and cost increase. Year books available for pick up at school in May. Year books can be mailed to international families for an additional fee.
- School Prom (Official All High School Dance): \$85.00 - \$100.00 per ticket, per year. School prom occurs in April. Formal attire is required.
- Formal Attire and Dress shoes required for multiple school events \$120-\$200.00 approximate. (Boys: Black dress slacks/pants (NO JEANS), collared long dress shirt, belt, dress socks, dress shoes. No tennis shoes or athletic shoes) (Girls: Black knee length skirt or dress, dress shoes)
- If English tutoring *is required* as part of an acceptance parents of student are responsible for all tutoring fees. Tutoring fees can range between \$65.00 to \$85.00 per hour. Tutoring could be required for up to 2-3 times a week for 1 semester or 2 semesters. Student's progress will be monitored and assessed at the completion of the first quarter. English tutoring will depend on the English ability of the student.
- Housing Fee: Housing is provided by the Study & Stay Hawaii vendor. Cost is generally approx. \$55.00 per day. Please register and request the most up to date fees from Study & Stay Hawaii.

- Physical and TB Clearance \$50.00-\$125.00 per enrollment term. Must be done by a U.S. Physician. Typically done in Honolulu by host family with international student.
- Personal spending money \$150.00 per month approx.
