

Joshua 1:1-9

After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: ² "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River **into the land I am about to give to them**—to the Israelites. ³ I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. ⁴ Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. ⁵ **No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you.**

⁶ **Be strong and courageous**, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.

⁷ **"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law** my servant Moses gave you; **do not turn from it to the right or to the left**, that you may be successful wherever you go. ⁸ **Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it.** Then you will be prosperous and successful. ⁹ **Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."**

There is a big difference between **DELIVERANCE** and **FREEDOM**

Joshua 3-4

As the priests carried the Ark the entire nation crossed over on dry ground.

Take twelve rocks out of the Jordan as a **remembrance**

Joshua 5

Every man had to be **circumcised**. The promise made to their fathers was for them.

Egypt's reproach was **healed**

When you possess a promise you **pay a price**.

(People paid a price before us)

God wants to do a new thing.

Joshua meets an angel from the Lord. He told him take off your sandals you are on **Holy Ground**.

The first thing they ran into was a **wall**.

Joshua 6

March around the city once a day for six days. Be quiet

March seven times around on the seventh day. Make noise.

- Doubt dies when **silenced**.
- If you can't speak **God's word** over your circumstances - don't say anything.
- Victory is in God's words **not yours**.
- God's will and promises are more important than the facts every time. **SPEAK HIS TRUTH**.

DON'T SETTLE: Be intentional

1. **Cut away** things that entangle you. **Hebrew 12:1**
2. Fill your life with **Jesus**.
3. Keep **moving on**. (From bad things or good things)

See - what God sees.

Say- what God says.
