

# QUESTIONS TO HELP THE SERMON STICK

## Connect To His Family February 11, 2018

1. Read Hebrews 10:24-25. Based on those verses, what can we do when we get together with other Christian believers? These are all actions we can take. Do you find some easier than others? Which ones?
2. What does Romans 12:5 say about the “body of Christ” (the church)? If part of your physical body is not working correctly then other parts have to compensate or something is left undone. Either way your body suffers AND the part that isn’t functioning doesn’t get the benefit of functioning with the body as well. Everything suffers. It is the same in with the “body of Christ”. When you are disconnected other parts have to compensate or things go undone. Ministry doesn’t happen as effectively AND you don’t get the benefit of being connected either. Everything suffers. If you have not connected to God’s family yet, what is stopping you?
3. Staying in Romans 12, when you read verses 9 through 13 which of these actions are the most challenging for you to do? Why? Which do you find the easiest?
4. Jesus’ teachings are frequently paradoxical, i.e. it is more blessed to give than to receive, the first will be last and vice versa. When you read Mark 8:35 what is the paradox? What words or phrases jump out to you? In your own words, how would you explain the phrase “for me and for the gospel will save it.” (NIV)
5. If you are connected to God’s family already, in what ways is it rewarding and satisfying? If you are not connected, what is your hesitation? Make the commitment to do it soon!
