Jury

The Jury will consist of the Chief of Competition, Technical Delegate, Assistant TD and CCC Race Director. At the discretion of the Jury, other experts may be invited to attend Jury Meetings as observers. Observers do not have a vote in Jury decisions.

Registration & Entry Fees

All registration will take place online, using **Zone4**, payable by Visa or MasterCard. Coaches **must** register on Zone4 (no fee).

Updates during the event will be sent to coaches using contact information from Zone4. For this reason it is important that all coaches register.

Open Men/Women:

Early Bird Registration Up to Nov 19th \$40 per race
Regular Registration Nov 20th to Dec 8th \$45 per race
Final Registration Dec 9th to Dec 11th \$55 per race

registration for early bird and final entry fees.

Racers and Coaches must check the confirmation list (available from the online registration section of Zone4) to ensure they are registered in the correct age and gender categories. Open (Senior M/W and Junior M/W), Junior B/G, Juvenile and Midget categories are included in the NorAm competition.

NorAm Entry Deadline

Monday December 11, 2017 – 23:59 P.S.T.

Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the jury and will incur an additional \$50 late fee per day.

Licences

All skiers must have a valid racing licence issued by CCC, FIS, or the national ski licensing body of another country. Skiers without a current national or international licence will be required to purchase a CCC Day Licence (SMDL) at registration. This applies to all skiers in categories from Juveniles to Senior. If a skier has both a CCC and FIS licence, **both** numbers must be provided at registration. Only skiers with FIS licences are eligible to receive cash prizes. Midget skiers must have a CCC Development license or purchase a SMDL at registration.

Waivers

Waivers must be accepted at online registration on Zone4.

Mini Tour

Skiers must start ALL stages of a multi-stage tour to be eligible for prize money, NorAm Aggregate Points and to receive preferred seeding. The preferred seeding protocol will be determined by the Competition Jury after review of the depth of field. Junior M/W electing to ski in the open heats will be considered as Senior M/W for the remainder of the MiniTour.

Seeding

Seeding protocol for the Open category is outlined in 6.9.1 (Interval start

distance), 6.9.3 (Sprints) and 6.9.4 (Rules for Multi-stage Tours) of the Haywood NorAm Series Technical Package 2.2.4:

In Multi-stage events, skiers not competing in all competitions will not be eligible for preferred seeding, prize money or NorAm Aggregate Points in subsequent competitions of the event. The OC may decide to offer a separate category for skiers who do not qualify for the multi-stage competition.

Saturday - Sprint

Senior Men and Junior Men categories and the Senior Women and Junior Women categories will be combined in the Qualification race for seeding purposes and run as a single open class but will be separated into junior and senior for heats and awards. The top 30 Junior M/W and Senior M/W will advance to quarterfinal heats. Unless the Competition Secretary receives notice of an athlete's intent at the start of the Team Captains' Meeting on Friday December 15, all qualifying Junior M/W will be entered into the Junior quarterfinal heats. No changes will be allowed on race day.

Junior B/G will advance to heats depending on numbers entered.

Pursuit Stage

Start times will be based on a Pursuit Start, with a skier's time behind the leader determining his/her start time. See Section 6.9.4 (Rules for Multistage Tours) of the Haywood NorAm Technical Package.

Bonus seconds will be allocated to the top 3 skiers from the interval start competition. Sprint bonus seconds will be applied to the final heat results of the top 30 skiers in the open class. Junior skiers electing to ski in the junior heats will not be eligible for bonus seconds but will remain eligible for the Multi-stage overall aggregate totals.

Haywood NorAm Awards

Awards will be presented immediately following the races each day to the top three skiers in each category. In the Open category, cash prizes will be given to the top three skiers after each individual competition and the top six overall aggregate skiers in the Mini-Tour. The top three U23 finishers will also be awarded cash prizes. See p7 of the Haywood NorAm Technical Package for cash purse amounts: Please note: only skiers with FIS licences are eligible for cash prizes.

Team Captains' Meetings

The Team Captains' meetings will be held at the Red Roof Church Hall (St Andrew's United Church, 2110 1st Ave, Rossland) for coaches of NorAm skiers as follows:

Thursday December 14th at 19:00 for Friday's Interval Start Friday December 15th at 19:00 for Saturday's Sprint Saturday December 16th at 19:00 for Sunday's Pursuit

NorAm Start Lists

Start lists for each race will be available after the Team Captains' meeting on the evening before the race. Start lists will also be posted on Zone4 and on the Black Jack website after the meeting.

Bib Pick-up

Bibs for each race can be picked up from the Race Office (located in the trailer in the parking area). See Event Timetable on p7 for bib pickup.

Course Maps

Maps of the race courses will be available before the event on the Black Jack website under the Noram 2017 tab.

Waxing Facilities

Outdoor electrical outlets for waxing will be available at the race site. Please plan accordingly by bringing your own wax tent where possible. We have very limited waxing facilities. No skis are permitted in the cabin. Teams are responsible for cleaning up their waxing area. A wax testing / warm up area will be provided near the waxing tents. No wax testing is allowed in the stadium area. The CCBC waxing protocol will be followed for the Midget age category – see CCBC protocol.

NorAm Protest Procedure

Protest forms will be available in the Race Office. Protests must be made within 15 minutes of posting the unofficial results. Note: a Cdn \$100 fee must accompany the protest form.

Food/Services

There will be limited food available on site on race days. Rossland shops/restaurants are a 10 minute drive, Red Mountain Resort is a 5 minute drive. There is no running water at the race site. There may be bottled water available for sale at the kiosk.

Trail Passes

There will be no trail fees charged to competitors, their coaches, and other team support personnel on race days and Thursday, Dec 14th the official training day. All persons who wish to ski on the trails outside these dates and conditions must purchase and display a valid trail pass or have a valid season pass. A discounted 3 day trail pass will be available for athletes and coaches and designated waxers for \$25 for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. These passes will not be available on site and must be pre-purchased on Zone4. Coaches and designated waxers must register on Zone4 to purchase the pass.

Weather

Race Cancellation

An alternate venue has been secured at a higher elevation if snow conditions are not suitable for holding the event at Black Jack ski trails. The date of the race will not be moved but cancellation of the race may be unavoidable due to weather conditions. If the event is cancelled a partial refund will be given to all competitors as per the technical package. For competitors that have to cancel before race entry deadline, a refund will be given less an administration fee.

Accommodation

The organizing committee has negotiated a significant discount with Red Mountain Resort Lodging for accommodation. They rent excellent

	quality condo style 1-4 bedroom apartments with full kitchens and underground parking, a 5 minute drive from the ski trails. Go to www.redreservations.com for further details. Waxing will be allowed in the underground parking area.
Travel Information	Castlegar Airport is a 30 minute drive from Rossland but is frequently difficult to fly in and out of in the winter. Other airport options include Kelowna, Spokane and Cranbrook (see below for times).
Distances to Rossland	Note: Black Jack ski trails are approximately a 10-minute drive from Rossland Vancouver = 620 km (approx. 8 hrs) Calgary = 630 km (approx. 8hrs) Spokane Airport = 215 km (approx. 2 hrs 45 mins) Kelowna Airport = 300 km (approx. 4 hrs) Cranbrook Airport = 255 km (approx. 3 hrs 30 mins)
