



2017 Miss Maine/MMOT General Rules, Regulations & Release Form

The Miss Maine Organization has developed the following rules and guidelines for your safety. Any violation will lead to immediate suspension from the Miss Maine Pageant.

As an official contestant vying for the title of Miss Maine/MMOT, she:

1. Must obey all federal and state laws.
2. Must maintain integrity, social conduct and decorum becoming of Miss Maine/MMOT.
3. Must be appropriate and respectful when using social media.
4. Must not smoke, use illegal drugs or consume alcohol.
5. Must abide by this contract or be disqualified.

During pageant week:

1. The Miss Maine Pageant will guide all activities and has full authority to make decisions regarding contestants.
2. A contestant may not be in the company of or speak to a judge except during regularly scheduled pageant events.
3. No one is permitted backstage other than pageant security, state personnel and pageant officials.
4. Long distance telephone bills and other incidentals are the responsibility of the contestant.
5. All problems or complaints should be reported to pageant officials immediately.
6. All gifts and flowers should be delivered to the hotel. Before sending flowers, be aware of allergies of roommates.
7. Contestants are to be ready twenty minutes before departure time.
8. Parents are not allowed in a contestant's room once she has been officially registered.
9. The Miss Maine Pageant will provide all transportation to and from Miss Maine/MMOT activities.
10. Be sure to label any and all competition wardrobe prior to arrival.
11. Bring thank you notes, which could be written during down time. You will be provided names and addresses of sponsors for pageant week.
12. Please do NOT bring expensive jewelry to the pageant. We are not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.
