



**HSWGA GENERAL MEMBERSHIP  
MEETING MINUTES  
Monday, November 6, 2017  
Coral Creek Golf Course**

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by President Barbara Schroeder at 1:15 P.M.
- II. Minutes of the February 27, 2017 General Membership meeting:
