In 2014, CESA 10 performed a detailed on-site audit of all buildings in the Chequamegon School District, and provided the District with a prioritized list of recommended facilities improvement measures (FIMs). Based on that list, the District chose to upgrade its HVAC systems, lighting, roofing, and kitchen spaces. These improvements not only conserve energy, they also contribute to the comfort and safety of building occupants. The District is currently saving more than \$40,000 annually in energy and maintenance costs, and is projected to save \$613,502 in utility costs and \$212,714 in operations and maintenance costs over a 20 year period.
