Position Overview

The Attack coach is hired in by a committee made up of a combination of the head of rules and training, CEO, LLC members and other league members as needed. As required, the committee will provide feedback from the league.

Essential Job Functions

- Works with Interleague Coordinator to schedule games and actively participates in email conversations in response to teams requesting games against GRRD
- Works in conjunction with Rules and Training (R&T) Committee to provide instruction in athletic conditioning for endurance, agility and strength
- Attends R&T meetings
- Demonstrate a working knowledge of current WFTDA derby rules
- Provide instruction in sports techniques, strategy, and tactics for competitive play
- Review GRRD game footage and watch footage of opposing teams
- Coordinate the leading of practices and content of each practice with Attack Captain(s), All Star Coach, All Star Captain(s), and Head of Rules and Training
- Coordinate with the attendance person, Membership Chair, and Treasurer regarding the eligibility of skaters for practice, game rostering and play time on game day
- Foster positive attitude of ethics, sportsmanship, teamwork, and responsibility individually and in relation to one's team
- Work in partnership with coaches and R&T Committee regarding overall direction of game play/strategy for league
- Communicate with other coaches, fostering leadership and teamwork amongst staff
- Be available to/supportive of coaches/captain(s) resolving skater issues/conflicts pertaining to team, practice and game day
- Follows established procedures for handling disputes or grievances

- Focus on strategy and advancement of All Stars, encourage leadership amongst All Stars to bridge gap with Attack
- Make game day rosters in cooperation with team captain(s) and coaches (All Stars and Attack)
 - Due 10 days prior to game (does not include tournament play as rosters may change daily/by game)
 - Check attendance/dues for skater eligibility
 - Communicate with any skaters that may be double rostered prior to posting (During tournament play notify skaters who fail to make the roster prior to posting roster to the team)
 - Post to GRRD Main Board, Announcer Folder (Google Docs), Interleague Coordinator, and Marketing/programs.
- Serve as Attack bench coach during home games, away games, and scrimmages

- In cooperation with captain(s) and co-bench coach, create/print 2-3 sets of lines for game day (20 rotations) and 2 “ideal” lines for power jams. Bring two copies of each (with 2” margin at top for clipboard) for bench coach that reads lines during the game
- Game Day
 - Lead/Attend off skates
 - Bench coach for Attack
 - May wear the captain alternate ‘A’ on game day or designate an alternate to wear the letter
 - Lead team warm up (15 minutes)
 - Attend Captain/Officials Meeting
 - Along with captain(s), lead team meeting prior to game
- Participate in quarterly evaluations and team placements
- Assist captain(s) and work with All Star Coach (if necessary) to create the Attack budget which is due annually. Budget includes extra practices, gas stipend for away games, hotel expenses for away games, tournament fees, training, etc.

Requirements

- Daily access to computer, email, Google Drive and Yahoo! Groups
- High organization skills
- Ability to interact and communicate with a variety of different league members and others outside of Grand Raggidy
- Bring a whistle, stop watch, and helmet covers to each practice
- Availability to attend at least two practices per week
