Position: Assistant Marine Educator

Duration: Wednesday, July 12th to Monday, August, 14th

Position will be 1-2 weeks within this time frame!

Time: Monday- Friday: 8:30am-3:15pm; Saturday, August 12th: 8:30am-3:15pm

Positions are unpaid and housing is not provided. Interns must have their own transportation.

Education Responsibilities:

- Assist the education staff in all aspects of the marine science, arts and advocacy programming.
- Lead small groups of students in activities.
- Be a group leader on field trips.

Other Responsibilities:

- At the end of the internship, the intern will present feedback regarding their internship to the Executive Director.
- Help with daily set up and cleanup of classroom.

Qualifications:

- Open to junior and senior high school students and any interested undergraduates.
- Strong passion or interest in one or all of the following:
 - Marine Science
 - The Arts (creative writing, music, performance, etc.)
 - Education
- Ability to pass a CORI Check.
- Able to work with students ages 10-12.
- Adaptable, willing to learn, and strong attention to detail.
- Outstanding communication and leadership skills.
- Must be able to work independently and as part of a team.
- Previous teaching experience, lab experience and/or art experience is a plus.
- If an intern plans to receive school credit for an internship they must notify staff prior to the internship start date, and it will be the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all required paperwork is completed and submitted.
