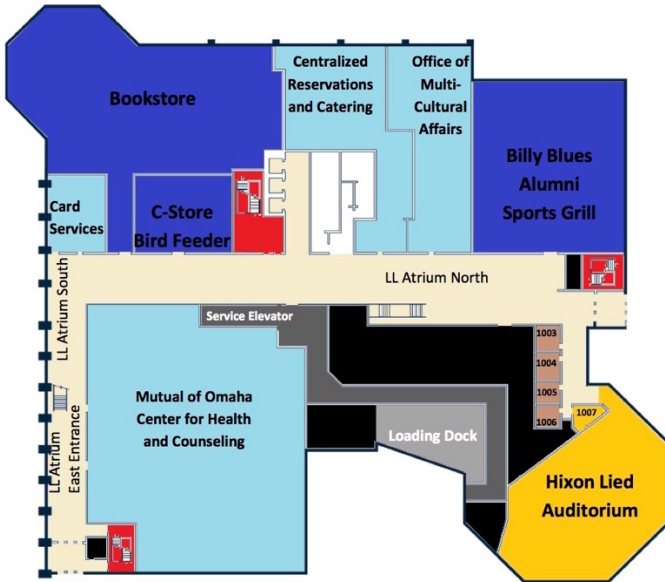

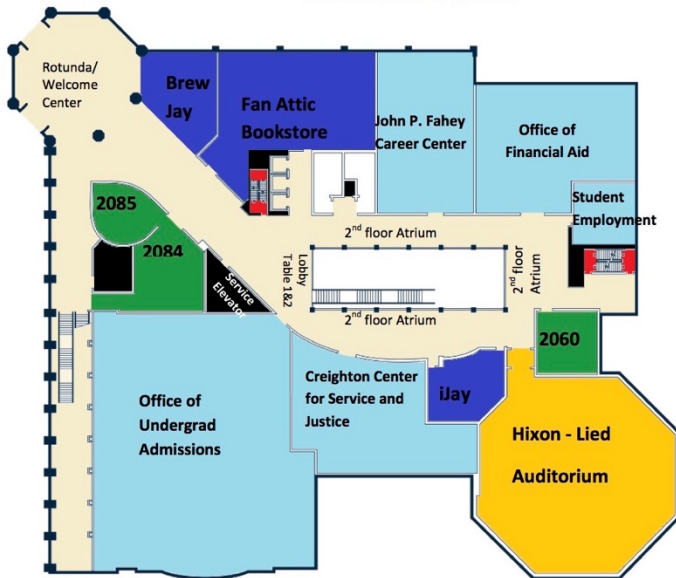
## First Floor
