The Nogales Interconnection Project draft Environmental Assessment (EA) (DOE/EA-2042) prepared by the United States (U.S.) Department of Energy (DOE) pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) and its implementing regulations is available for your review and comment.

The International Boundary and Water Commission, U.S. Section; U.S. Forest Service; and Staff of the Arizona Corporation Commission are cooperating agencies in preparing the Nogales Interconnection Project draft EA.

The DOE proposed action in the draft EA is the decision whether or not to issue a Presidential permit to the applicant, Nogales Transmission, L.L.C., that would authorize the international border crossing of a proposed new, approximately
