



ANCONIA ANNOUNCES FINAL CLOSING OF PRIVATE PLACEMENT

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Toronto – March 24, 2015 – Anconia Resources Corp. (TSXV: ARA) (“Anconia”) is pleased to announce that it has closed the second and final tranche of the private placement offering (the “**Offering**”) previously announced on February 19, 2015. The first tranche, which closed and was announced on March 5, 2015, raised gross proceeds of \$300,000 on the terms of the Offering, which are summarized below. The second tranche, which closed on March 20, 2015 raised an additional \$68,000 on the same terms.

Anconia has applied for and received conditional approval from the TSX Venture Exchange (the “**TSXV**”) for a waiver from the \$0.05 minimum price requirement. Under the terms of the Offering, Anconia issued 18,400,000 units (“**Units**”) for gross proceeds from both closings of \$368,000. The Units were issued at \$0.02 per Unit. Any securities issued under the Offering would be subject to a statutory hold period for four months and one day from the date of issuance. The hold periods applicable to each tranche of the Offering, expire, accordingly, on July 6, 2015 and July 21, 2015.

Each Unit consists of one common share of Anconia and one common share purchase warrant (a “**Unit Warrant**”). Each Unit Warrant entitles the holder to purchase one common share of Anconia at a price of \$0.05 per share for a period of 36 months following the date of issuance.

The aggregate proceeds raised under the Offering will be used for working capital purposes and for further exploration work on Anconia’s Grenfell property. Any additional proceeds will be used primarily for further exploration on Anconia’s Grenfell property and Anconia may use up to 20% of the gross proceeds for fees or salary to management. No other payments would be made to related parties apart from this amount.
