S Genesis 2

1. What was Adam to do in the garden?
 2. What instructions about the 2 trees in the middle of the garden did God give to Adam?

A God knew if Adam ate the fruit he would die. God's goal was to protect Adam, not to keep him from something enjoyable. What other ways of obeying God keep you from dangerous things?

Day 1

P Lord, help me to do what you ask me to do by the best of my abilities.

S Genesis 3

- O**
1. What did God say not to do?
 2. How did Adam and Eve respond when God asked them what they did?

A We may not be able to do everything right, but we can be someone who admits when we are wrong. When you admit you are wrong, how does it affect people's view of you? How does it affect God's view of you?

P Pray God would give you the courage to admit when you are wrong.

1. Describe how the people in this time period were not following God's directions.
 2. How was Noah different?
 3. What did God ask Noah to do?

1. About how old was Noah when God asked him to build the ark?

When God asked Noah to build the ark, his immediate obedience communicated to God that he trusted God and followed Him.

A This week when your parents ask you to do something, follow Noah's pattern of immediate obedience and see how it impacts your parents.

P This week, remind me to immediately obey so I can communicate trust and respect.
