1. Abram and his family went to Egypt. What did Abram ask his wife, Sarai, to do? Did she do it?
2. What happened to Pharaoh and his household? What did Pharaoh then do?

A

Abram thought no one would find out the truth. Not only did they learn that Abram lied, but Pharaoh and his household were the ones who suffered. How does your sin affect other people?

Lord, I ask for wisdom to make the right choices whenever I am asked to do something.

1. Melchizedek king of Salem came to Abram. What kind of person was He? What did He do to Abram?
2. What did Abram do in response to Melchizedek's blessing? Do you know what a tithe is? It is giving a tenth of what you earn back to God. Have you ever tithed?

A

The next time you have the chance to earn some money, are given an allowance, or money as a gift what should you do with a tenth of it? God will be faithful to bless your obedience.

P

Thank you God for being able to give back to You with my tithes.
