Along with S.O.A.P. memorizing one scripture a week will help you make Gods word's apart of your life.

S Genesis 24

1. What did Eliezer, Abraham's servant, ask God to do? What was the specific request?
2. Why did the servant ask that the woman would be willing to water the camels as well?

A

When asked to help or when you see a need, go beyond the minimum of what needs done. Develop a servant spirit. What can you do to develop a servant's heart?

Day 1

P

Lord, open my eyes to see ways I can be helpful to others.

1. What were the names of Isaac's two sons?
2. What did the older brother sell to the younger brother? What did this mean?

A

Bad things can happen when you act before thinking. What has happened to you when you did something without considering the consequences?

Day 2

P

Lord, I ask for the strength and for a clear mind to consider the effects of my actions before I do them.

1. What did Isaac ask Esau to do and who overheard it?
2. Who actually received the blessing from Isaac and what happened because of it?

A

When have you ever been worried about getting caught if you were going to do something wrong? Let this be a warning to do what is right.

Day 3

P

Lord, may I be sensitive to the Holy Spirit when He tells me I am doing something wrong.

1. Where did Isaac tell Jacob to go?
 2. What happened in Jacob's dream? In verse 13, what does God call Himself?

A Your parents may have taught you about God or you may be learning about Him at church. It's important for you to know that you, like Jacob, need to establish your own personal relationship with God. What habits can you follow to do this?

Day 4

P Lord, I want to know You more and I want to establish my own personal relationship with You. Enable me to understand Your Word and do it.

1. Who did Jacob meet in Paddan Aram?
 2. Who did Jacob want to marry and how long did he work in order to marry her?

Day 5

P Lord, enable me to do my best at whatever I am doing.

1. What new name did Jacob receive?
 2. Why was Jacob's name changed?

A It is easy to give up when things become hard, boring, or take a lot of time. Don't stop, instead persevere. In what areas of your spiritual life do you need to be persistent?

P God, Let me not become weary in doing good. For Your Word says at the proper time I will reap a harvest if I **do not give up**. (Galatians 6:9)
