2. What emotions did Joseph have after he told his brothers who he was?

A

Joseph's brothers hated him, rejected him, and sold him into slavery, but Joseph forgave them. What are your responses when people treat you wrongly and how can you be like Joseph?

P

Lord, enable me to be kind and compassionate to others, forgiving them, just as in Christ You forgave me. Eph 4:32
