ACTIVITY CHECKLIST



CUT + GLUE

WHAT YOU NEED

- old magazines or catalogs
- heavy paper
- scissors
- glue

Optional

- markers
- stickers, glitter glue, or any other type of embellishment

HOW-TO

Have your little one cut out anything that is of interest, and glue to pieces of paper. If your little is fairly young (3 or younger), she'll need a bit of help and will probably be content just with the excitement of pasting things.

YOU MIGHT ALSO...

If you have a pre-schooler or older kid in the mix, encourage them to make a mixed media project by pasting images to a drawing. Some ideas to get you started:

- draw a house and glue furniture/people/objects into it
- draw a garden and glue flowers/plants into it
- create a menu and glue images of food into it

Talk with your little about the images you cut out - the size, the color, the shape, and what you can do with them both in real life and in your project.
