

Mission statement:

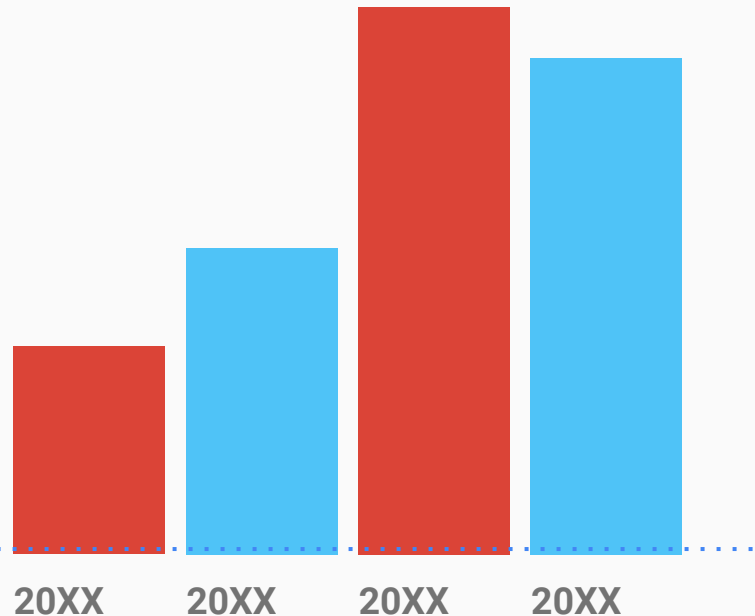
To create an app that is easy to use in an event of an emergency.
