Notes

Students will be required to submit their subject choices and their ILP 5 year plan.

All subject selections will be assessed by an Assistant Principal or Head of House before being confirmed.

If a student starts a subject that proves to be too difficult at that time they can simply reselect another subject.

VCAL can be attempted after completion of the Entry Class.

VCAL will be offered in two versions. One will be based on 3 days at school, one day at TAFE and one day in the workforce. The other is based on five days at school.

Some subjects at VCE level will have prerequisites in order to ensure students have a realistic opportunity to succeed and do not disadvantage other students.

Students will then receive their initial subjects. At this stage we hope that students can select from a choice of teachers for subjects where multiple classes run
