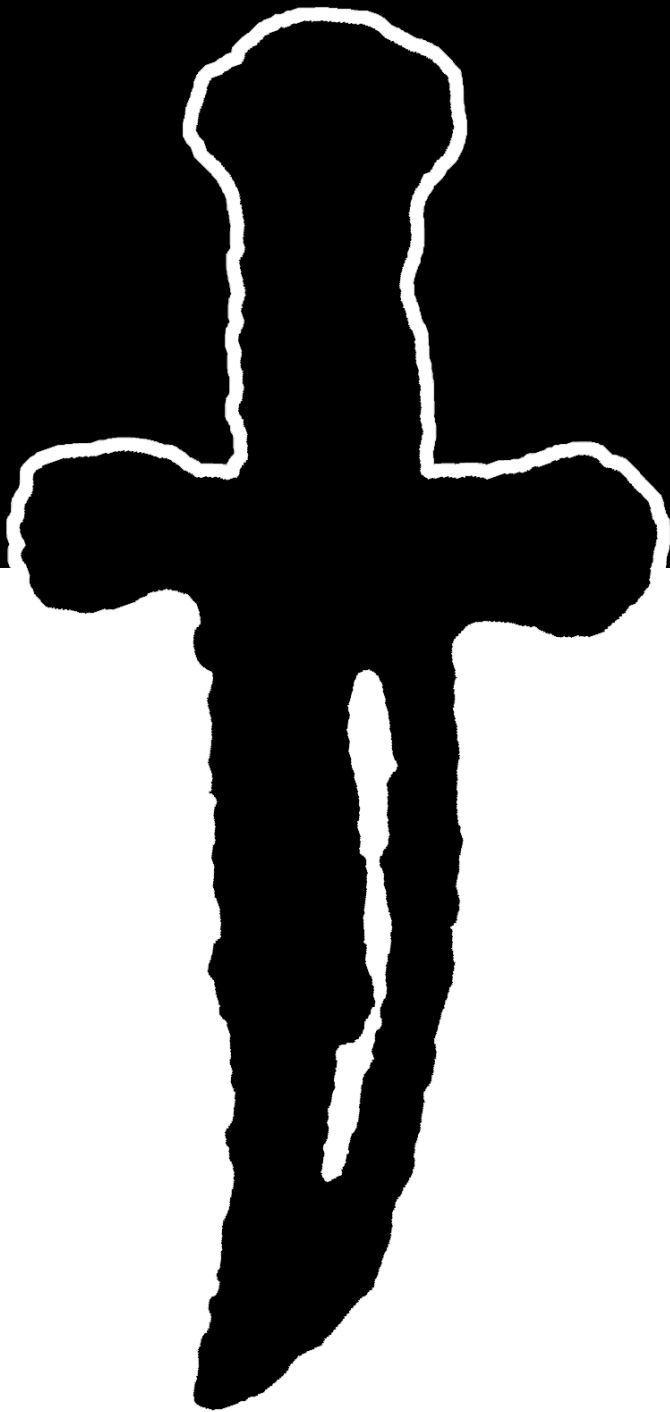


# Sound Shank



The Sound Shank is an aggressive germanium fuzz device based on the vintage “Buzzaround” fuzz unit. Loads of gain textures on tap through the use of the Sustain and Timbre controls, from subtle grit with loose ends through a tight and focused crunch. This version of the Sound Shank differs from the earlier units. It has been updated for a wider gain range, negative ground for the use of a standard, negative ground power supply. The Sound Shank is true bypass, all discrete analog circuitry and handmade one and a time in buzzy Akron, Ohio.

## **Controls**

**Timbre-** Controls the output overall tone. Paper thin AM sounds to the left, full on badassery to the right.

**Sustain-** Controls the amount of ripping crunch.

**Level-** This makes it louder and/or quieter.

## **Power**

Any standard regulated 9-volt DC power supply with a negative center 2.1mm barrel, or a 9 volt battery will power this device.

## **For best results:**

- Do not place this device before buffered pedals.
- Do not leave this device in excessive heat or excessive cold. Doing so will result in a dead splatty fuzz. Once it returns to “room temperature” it will stabilize and function as intended.
