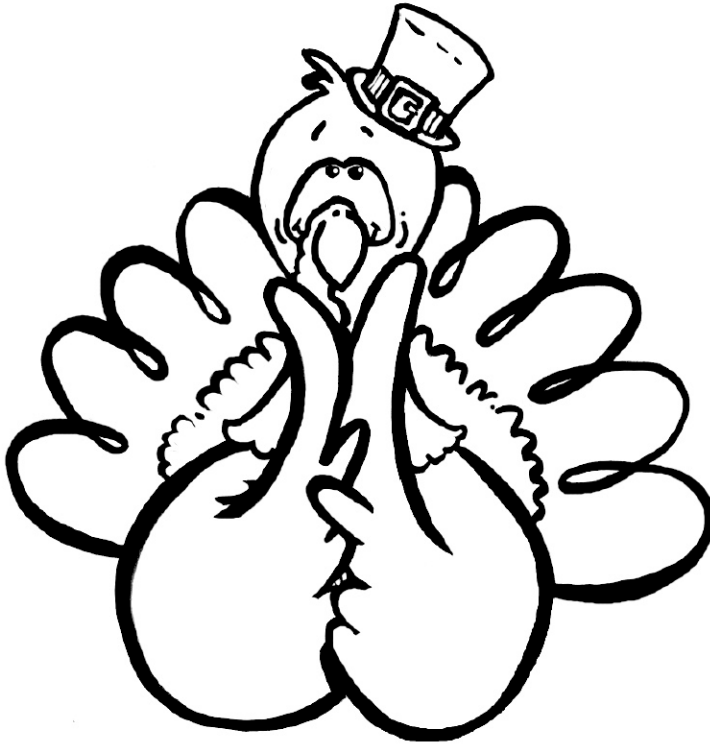


THE "THANKFUL" TURKEY



Materials

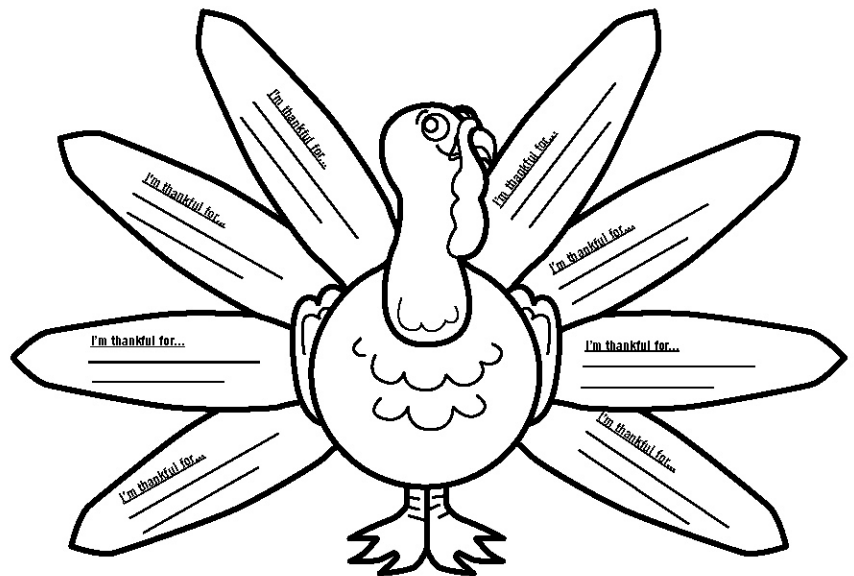
- Scissors (1 pair per student)
- Colors
- Pencil
- Turkey pattern for each student

DIRECTIONS

1. Have students use scissors to cut out the turkey and its feathers.
2. Ask students to write on the lines the things they are thankful for.
3. Students then can color the feathers and attach them to the back of their turkey with glue and tape.

Remember, we all need to be thankful for farmers! You may even want to have students send their "Thankful Turkeys" to local farmers. Contact your parish Farm Bureau office to identify farmers in your area.
