
BURGER SNACKS





Materials

2 vanilla wafers . . . "hamburger buns"
1 chocolate cookie . . . "hamburger"
Red icing "ketchup"
Yellow icing "mustard"
Green coconut "lettuce"

DIRECTIONS

Learn about agricultural products and farms while enjoying a "burger" treat!

- **1.** Color coconut green with food coloring.
- 2. Place a small amount of yellow icing on one vanilla wafer. Place chocolate cookie on top.
- 3. Place small amount of red icing on top of chocolate cookie. Sprinkle with coconut "lettuce." Place second vanilla wafer on top.

Students may eat their "hamburgers" when finished. IMPORTANT NOTE: Always remember to check for food allergies first!

Concept Development:

You can add to the depth of this simple activity by discussing or researching where the actual parts of a hamburger come from.

For example, the bun is made of wheat. Where in the United States is wheat grown?
