NOTICE is hereby given that, in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Mexico and the Ruidoso Municipal Code, a Special meeting of the newly elected officials of the Governing Body, shall be held at 1:00 p.m. on Monday March 7, 2016. The meeting will be held in the Council Chambers of the Ruidoso Administrative Center Building, 313 Cree Meadows Drive, Ruidoso.

The purpose of the meeting is to conduct certain items of business which will provide for the continuity of government for the Village of Ruidoso.

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1. Moment of Silence/Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Oaths of Office and Presentation of Certificates of Election.
3. Community Address by Mayor Battin, and request remarks from other Elected Officials.
4. Pursuant to New Mexico State Statutes 3-12-3A, the Governing Body shall elect one of its members to act as Mayor Pro Tem in the absence of the Mayor (Mayor Battin is Recommending Lynn D. Crawford as Mayor Pro Tem).
5. Powers and duties of the Village of Ruidoso Governing Body and discussion of same, if desired (New Mexico State Statutes Chapter 3, Articles 10, 11 and 12). 1
6. In accordance with law, the Mayor shall submit, for confirmation by the Governing Body, the names of the persons who shall be employed to fill the appointed offices of Manager-Treasurer (Debra Lynne Lee), Chief of Police (Darren Hooker), Municipal Clerk (Irma Devine), and Attorney (Zachary J. Cook).
7. Adoption of Resolution 2016-08, a Resolution setting forth notice provisions for notices of public meetings of the Governing Body of the Village of Ruidoso. 9
8. Affirmation of Resolution 2014-24, a Resolution Establishing Policy for the Agendas and Procedures for Regular Meetings, Special Meetings, Emergency Meetings, and Workshop Meetings of the Governing Body of the Village of Ruidoso. 13
9. Affirmation of Resolution 2011-14, a Resolution of the Village of Ruidoso Governing Body Adopting a Code of Ethics Policy. 21
