

Inclement Weather Cancellation Policy

Poor weather is always a possibility during the winter months. Canceling a GID is our last resort, and we have not had to do so, however, in case it is necessary, we developed this emergency cancellation policy. For our purposes, "inclement weather" refers to regional snow or ice events that make traveling too dangerous for our volunteers, staff and participants.

If such weather warnings & conditions are on the news, please check your email for a message from Slighe nan Gaidheal/EventBrite. You may also receive a phone call from a member of the Gaelic Education Committee, informing you of the decision to cancel the GID. You may receive this call as early as 7AM or shortly thereafter. We apologize in advance for the early time for this phone call, but we have participants who travel from far away, and some that take ferries to get to our GIDs. We hope you will understand.

Note: In the unlikely event of a cancellation, we will use either our January or May Language Enrichment Day date as a make-up class and your registration will be transferred to that date.

It is essential that the contact information you provide us on your registration form include your emergency contact information. If your information changes during the Z2G season, especially during the fall and winter months, please inform the Gaelic Education Officer of these changes by emailing Nina Chambers at nchambers7@comcast.net. We would hate for you to arrive at the venue to discover the event has been cancelled.

Thank you for working with us so we are prepared for inclement weather.
