



Dear Resident,

You may be aware of our trial monthly food market that commenced in March on Northfield Avenue.

Our first event took place on Saturday 18 March and was well received by local residents. We now plan to continue holding the markets on the pavement of Northfield Avenue, which will result in no road closures. The markets will be run under a temporary Street Trading License with permission from Ealing Council. We have received a large amount of great feedback from the March event via emails / messages from a number of residents – thank you for your support and input.

The markets on Northfield Avenue are being run as a trial to help determine if a market is suitable for the area and is wanted by local residents and businesses. To help determine this, Ealing Council with our support will be undertaking consultation through-out the trial period. This will include collecting feedback during and after the events and a public survey.

I attended the local ward forum meeting earlier this month, as did representatives of the council, and informed those present of the above plans, confirming that we will no longer be applying for any road closures for this market, as per the original market plans.
