Job Description

Instructors deliver residential, 1-5 day STEM and environmental educational programs to 4th - 8th grades from New England schools. The hands on lessons focus on building critical thinking skills, exploring connections among the natural and manmade world, and understanding the role of science in careers. Instructors also facilitate team building curriculum (initiatives and low ropes) to develop students’ leadership and problem solving skills.

Instructors are responsible for educating a group of 12-15 students throughout the program, including facilitating day and night lessons and large group activities and leading meals. All instructors participate regularly in tasks that support our programs including: housekeeping, kitchen, office work, debriefs, and trainings. Instructors are supervised and trained by the Program Director.
